October 2017 Meeting Re-Cap

Over 75 members and guests attended the meeting. Plaques were distributed from the September tournament. If you did not pick up your plaque, check with Josh Tidmore.

Greg Smith spoke on behalf of The Guy T. Smith #883 Masonic Lodge Annual Speckled Trout Tournament held Saturday, October 14 at C&S Marina, off Deer River Road. No results were reported from the tournament.

Michael Nicholas spoke on behalf of the Alabama Power Company fishing tournament to be held at C&S Marina on Saturday November 4th. Contact Michael for details.

John Burke then gave an in-depth Power Point presentation on 'reel maintenance', concentrating on the care, upkeep and upgrades of popular spinning reels. He went into detail about obtaining the schematics for reels and a proper procedure for their disassembly, cleaning and reassembly. John listed some popular lubricants and protectorates to help keep our reels spinning smoothly for years to come. This was followed by a lively Q&A session, including a personal testimony and recommendation by ACFA President John Howard. John Burke 'does his daddy proud', and continues in the Burke tradition of contributing to the ACFA!





After the break, we were treated to an intimate Power Point briefing of the Theodore Industrial Canal (TIC) by Kim "Sarge" Griffin. After serving our nation in Iraq (where he was severely wounded), "Sarge" retired and took up fishing. Soon, saltwater fishing became a passion as he endeavored to learn the intricacies of successfully fishing this unique corner of the bay. Its plentiful natural bait supply along with lots of structure, sandy 'nooks & crannies' and nearby deep water access makes the TIC an ideal habitat for Speckled Trout and other inshore saltwater species, which Sarge detailed for us. Additionally, he issued a challenge of sorts for anglers to move out of their 'comfort zones' and learn new fishing spots, both in the canal and in other locales around the bay. In so many ways, Sarge exemplifies the great American spirit of our military men and women, and what they stand and fight for. We thank you for your service to our country and for sharing your experiences and fishing knowledge with us!

To end the meeting, John Howard recapped the 'volunteer 5 point' incentive for members who devote their day (and fishing time) to make our tournaments so successful. We hope this will generate more interest from our membership to step up and keep this the best local inshore fishing club!

October 2017 "Causeway Classic" Tournament Recap

Anglers had pretty decent mild weather for the tournament day; however, the wind picked up a bit from the east by midmorning. Some impressive catches were still brought to the scales at the Café Del Rio from 1 til 3 pm. Several nice redfish, flounder and sheepshead were added to the Big Fish Contest, and a couple more redfish were just a little over the 'slot' limit (26").

The heaviest fish of the day was Vicki Foster's 7.85 lb sheepshead, which dwarfed Mike Foster's 6.07 lb second place fish. Mike gets the Net man points; -) Again this month, redfish was a hotly contested category, with all 5





places at or well over 5 pounds. In fact John Howard brought in two redfish over 7 pounds! And hot on his heels was Bill Graves' 6.82 lb red.

These are outstanding fish that will be contestants on the Big Fish Board.

Another impressive 'catch-of-the-day' was Jake Swearingen's 4.87 lb flounder caught from the seawall across the highway from the weigh-in location. Not far behind though was Jennifer (Hines) Minto with a 4.32 lb 'fatty flattie'. You know how proud her husband Lee is about that! Dale Pierce's fine 3.68 lb flounder was the first fish weighed in, and it was on the Big Fish Board until these other two flounder muscled their way in.



John Howard asked John Burke to fish with him for this tournament (named in honor of his dad's contributions to the ACFA). So it seemed only fitting when

John caught the heaviest speckled trout landed on artificial to receive that coveted plaque. Michelle Nall would have barely edged him out of first place in that category, but she and her husband Henry were fishing live shrimp. Other anglers reported 'fair' to 'good' catches of specks, but those over 20" long were scarcer than live shrimp at the bait shops after 7 am. The bite should only get better with the cooler weather forecast in the coming weeks.



Several Junior anglers brought in specks, with Caleb Gates edging out Miles Jackson for second place. But it was 5 year old Cooper Garmeson who came out with the heaviest speckled trout at 2.46 lb. He also had a 3.87 lb sheepshead to take that junior angler category as well. That's two first place plaques for Cooper! His dad, Pat, and mom, April, are very proud of him.

The food and staff at Café Del Rio were excellent and the venue is just fantastic, especially considering they were flooded (from "Nate") just two weeks before our tournament. We hope they will consider the ACFA presence as a 'win-win' for both them and us next year;-)

Well that wraps up our tournament season for 2017. Congratulations to the winners and all those who have participated in making this the biggest and most successful inshore fishing club in the region.

The Big Fish Contest continues until Tuesday November 14th. So there's still plenty of great fish to be caught in the coming weeks.
